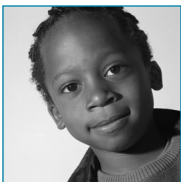

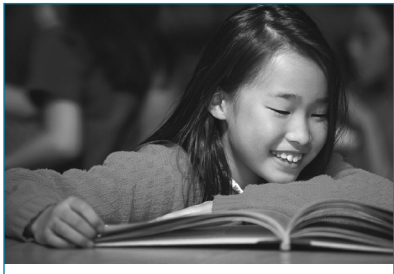
- ▶ From Route 476 (the Blue Route) exit onto Germantown Pike West. Continue 2.7 miles to Route 202 North. Turn right on 202 North and proceed 2.8 miles. The club is located on the west side of 202 at Morris Road. There is a traffic light at the entrance to Blue Bell Country Club (across from Montgomery County Community College). Enter at the gatehouse and follow Tournament Drive to the clubhouse on the left side of the road.
- ▶ From Route 309 turn right onto Route 202 South. Proceed South on 202 (approximately 10 minutes). The club is located on the west side of 202 at Morris Road. There is a traffic light at the entrance to Blue Bell Country Club (across from Montgomery County Community College). Enter at the gatehouse and follow Tournament Drive to the clubhouse on the left side of the road.
