- Tiered Tasks
- Curriculum Compaction
- Study Guide Plan
- Adding Complexity to Current Lessons
- Most Difficult First

Participants are asked to bring materials for a unit that could/should include: Student Learning Map or Curriculum Map, K-U-D, formative and summative assessments, lesson plans, and any supplementary materials. Ideally this session works best with a team of general educators (grade level or department) and a gifted support teacher/instructional specialist/instructional coach.
