

LEGAL CURRENCY IN SPECIAL EDUCATION:

The Latest under the IDEA and Section 504

with Guest Speaker, Perry Zirkel



This one-day program will provide a legal update for special education leaders.

AM SESSION: The morning will focus on recent case law under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), specifically the Supreme Court decisions in 2017—Andrew F. and Fry—and published judicial rulings in the Third Circuit and Pennsylvania.

PM SESSION: The afternoon will focus on the current eligibility standards and other student issues under Section 504 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The afternoon segment will include two alternate eligibility forms for 504-only students and recent legal developments that extend to students with IEPs.



Perry A. Zirkel is university professor emeritus of education and law at Lehigh University, where he formerly was dean of the College of Education, subsequently held the Iacocca Chair in Education for its five-year term, and continues to co-direct the Lehigh Special Education Law Symposium. He has a Ph.D. in Educational Administration and a J.D. from the University of Connecticut, and a Master of Laws degree from Yale University. He has done presentations in every state in the U.S. He has written more than 1,550 publications on various aspects of school law, with an emphasis on legal issues in special education.
