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The Wechsler Individual Achievement Test (WIAT-4) is a comprehensive assessment of oral language, reading, written expression and mathematics that will be released in the Fall of 2020. Dr. McCloskey will describe changes from the WIAT-III to the WIAT-4, identify new subtests and composites, and discuss how psychologists can use the WIAT-4 results to determine eligibility for specialized services and identify goals for intervention.
