

# WILSON READING SYSTEM® (WRS)

SCHOOL YEAR LONG PROGRAM CERTIFICATION

This school year long WRS Level I Certification training is designed to prepare teachers to effectively implement Steps 1-6 of the Wilson Reading System with students reading and spelling below grade level and those diagnosed with a language-based learning disability. Participants will demonstrate mastery of the Wilson® lesson plan, including multisensory techniques and effective strategies in a 1:1 setting. Certification provides extensive training and support enabling teachers to effectively implement the program with fidelity. Certification includes approximately 90 hours of online coursework, a 65-lesson practicum, including demonstration, observation and feedback from a Wilson® Credentialed Trainer. The time, effort and study involved with this program are considerable. Each trainee is expected to acquire a very sophisticated working knowledge of the sound-symbol system of English (phonology) and its structure (morphology), as well as the use of specific diagnostic techniques in teaching reading, spelling, vocabulary, prosody, and comprehension.

## PREREQUISITE:

Must have completed the WRS Introductory Course within the last 5-years. (Offered at MCIU on May 7-9 or August 14-16, 2019.)

Participants will need to administer the WIST assessment kit for pre/post-testing practicum student requirements. In addition, participants will need to administer a standardized normed reading test with subtests that compare word attack to comprehension skills.
